

## **MWPA Business Meeting**

Saturday, November 5, 2005

**1. Call to order** at 12:05 pm

**2. Treasurer's Report** – There is just under \$5,000 in the Association account.

**Proposal** (D. VanderJagt) – Post-season entry fees shall be made payable to the host site. Team entry fees remain \$75 for Districts, \$125 for Regionals, and \$200 for States. Host site issues one check to MWPA to cover referee and hosting fees. These amounts are now \$500 for Districts, \$1500 for Regionals, and \$2600 for States. Host site keeps all other income (tickets, concessions, etc.). MWPA will pay the officials. *Adopted unanimously*

**3. Director of Officials' Report** – It has been a good season, and there seem to be more officials working. There are plans for two officials' clinics early in the spring season. The Director's desire is to have more evaluation tournaments (not necessarily with classroom sessions), where officials can received further feedback and training.

**Q** - What are the selection criteria for State Championship officials?

**A** - The Director takes feedback from the coaches into account. Officials who wish to work in the post-season must pass a written rules test. It is suggested that some "east side" and "west side" officials cross-over to the other region to be seen by those coaches, ideally during the season, not just at Districts or Regionals.

**Q** – Is it possible to know the pool of officials working post-season earlier in the year?

**Q** – Can one post-season crew be used, so that the Regional referees have all worked at Districts, and the State referees have all worked at a Regional?

**A** – Both situations above would be ideal, but not always feasible. It was difficult this year to even get enough officials interested and available to work at the post-season events.

**Q** – Can the Director of Officials work the state meet?

**A** – Yes, and he was prepared to do so this year, but had a fine group of officials available to work, allowing him to be a non-officiating Head Referee.

#### **4. All-Tournament/All-State Voting**

**Proposal** (B. Murden) - For All-Tournament and All-State (Season) Teams, voters may vote for one and only one goalie in the First Team, and one and only one goalie in the Second Team. The goalie with the most votes is selected to the First Team. The goalie with the second most votes is selected to the Second Team. No restrictions on number of goalies on Third Team (may be 0). In case of a tie for First or Second, the tied goalies would share the honor, and the team size will be increased by one (there would still be at least six field players on each of the First and Second teams). *Adopted unanimously.*

#### **5. Standardize Post-Season Tournament Formats**

**Proposal** (D. VanderJagt) – Set standard formats to be used for District, Regional, and State Championship Tournaments, so that all tournaments use the same timing and schedule formats, and to minimize the amount of class time missed by student-athletes. Start times and timing factors adjusted during discussion for most commonality and to maximize the benefit to the student-athletes. Formats attached at end of minutes. *Adopted unanimously.*

#### **6. 2006 Girls' Post-season Sites**

State Championship - Saline (tent), (U-M possible backup - Will Hart) 6/2-3  
East Regional - Saline 5/19-20  
West Regional – Jenison, 5/19-20  
North District – (AA Huron tent; to be discussed) 5/12-13  
South District - AA Huron, 5/12-13  
East/West Districts - Rockford, 5/12-13

Saline should know in mid-November whether they can host the State Championship. Will Hart will investigate the use of University of Michigan as a backup site (booking U-M must be done early). North and South Districts discussed using Huron as a sole site for both Districts. All sites should be confirmed prior to the next Business Meeting, 2/12/06.

*Updated January 2006: East Lansing HS will host the State Championship.*

#### **7. Officials' Ballot for All-Region and All-State**

**Proposal** (M. Westgate, via A. Briggs) – Allow the officiating crew to have one collective ballot for All-Regional Tournament and All-State Tournament teams (including Coach of the Year for each event). *Adopted unanimously.*

## **8. Clarification of Awards at championship tournaments**

The Association assigned to the Executive Board the task to define what awards are handed out and who is responsible for producing them (MWPA or site), and to announce their decision at or before the 2/12/06 Business Meeting.

## **9. Other Items**

L. Winkelman - There are discrepancies between the published Bylaws and Policies and the current accepted ways of doing business and running championships (as defined over the past several business meetings). These discrepancies should be cleared up.

Board Response: Secretary Brian Fickies is preparing the corrections, and should have them ready for approval by the next Business Meeting.
